STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE AD-HOC COMMITTEE ON HOMELESSNESS AND APPOINTING COUNCILMEMBERS SOL JOBRACK, KIMBERLY WARMSLEY, AND VICE MAYOR CHRISTINA FUGAZI, WITH COUNCILMEMBER DAN WRIGHT AS ALTERNATE, TO SERVE ON THE COMMITTEE

The City Council desires to establish an ad-hoc committee to serve in an advisory capacity and review progress on the efforts toward addressing homelessness within the city; and

Council Policy 100-4 authorizes the City Council to establish ad-hoc committees targeted towards specific issues; and

The policy requires that ad-hoc committees be established by resolution of the Council, with appointments to be made by the Mayor based on the expertise and expressed interest of the Councilmembers; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. This City Council hereby approves the formation of the Ad-Hoc Committee on Homelessness to serve in an advisory capacity and review progress on the efforts toward addressing homelessness with the city.

2. The following Councilmembers are appointed to serve on the Ad-Hoc Committee on Homelessness:

Councilmember Sol Jobrack (Chair)
Councilmember Vice Mayor Fugazi (Vice-chair)
Councilmember Kimberly Warmsley
Councilmember Dan Wright (Alternate)

3. The Ad-Hoc Committee on Homelessness will report its progress to the Council at the discretion of the Chair.
